Soufriere Adventure Tour

(Minimum of 20 pax to confirm)

Time: 9am to 4pm Mon. - Sat.

Cost: \$125US per adult/ \$65US per child

A full day sail and site-seeing tour including visits to the Sulphur Springs mud bath and waterfall. Includes lunch on the boat, drinks, view of the Pitons, swimming, and

snorkeling.

Sail down the breath-taking west coast bypassing local fishing villages and scenic coastline to the town of Soufriere home of the worlds' famous majestic Pitons.

Upon arrival in Soufriere you will enjoy a short journey to the Sulphur Springs where you will have the choice of the guided tour of the world's only drive-in volcano or experience the hot springs and mud bath (Its rumored you will leave here 10 years younger.)

On our return up the coast on the Catamaran we will stop at a protected reef and swimming area for a refreshing swim or snorkeling where you will be delighted to see an array of colorful marine life.

We pass through Marigot Bay one of the Caribbean's most beautiful bays for some amazing photos.

Then it's party time the rum punch is flowing, and the crew get dancing as we party our way back to dock.

Segway Adventure

Time: Between 9am - 11am Daily

Cost: \$100US per person (no child price)

Glide on our scenic nature trail up beautiful Mount Pimard and enjoy breath taking views of St. Lucia's dramatic West Coast.

First stop is "Pebble Beach" where local fishermen are often seen hunting for dinner and many rock skipping contests have been waged. Next its up, up, up the mountain side with many photo spots and educational stops along the way such as the now sealed bunkers that once served as tunnels, storage and lookouts for the American Military during World War 2. Once at our highest viewing point, Morne Pimant, guests are served local juices and fruits and invited to participate in a short walk up the volcanic masterpiece and experience "StoneFace Fishpond", fish food and cameras strongly recommended.

Enjoy "Belle View Point" for panoramic views of Pigeon Island, Reduit Beach, The Rodney Bay Marina and the Caribbean Sea. Lastly you will enjoy a relaxing glide along the beach passing the ever accommodating "Lucian Style Beach Hut" and feeling the sea breeze cool your soul.

Morne Pimard Hike

Time: Between 9am - 11am Daily **Cost:** \$50US per person (no child price)

Enjoy an exhilarating and scenic hike accompanied by our well-trained guides up to the breathtakingly beautiful summit of Mount Pimard - located in St. Lucia's Tourism capital of Rodney Bay. Heard of the Pitons, right? Well, this is the only other mountain hike on the island (apart from the Piton hike) which is surrounded by 180 degrees of water. Hike with the water at your back and the mountain at your feet as you learn about the interesting and captivating history of St. Lucia and the immediate area.

Gros Piton Hike:

Time: 6:35am Mon./Wed./Fri. (Min 4 pax) **Cost:** \$160US per person (no child price)

Towering nearly 3,000 feet above sea level, the majestic peak of Gros Piton, along with its twin peak Petit Piton, dominates the western coast of St Lucia. The view itself is a classic, the Pitons of Saint Lucia, soaring straight up from the sea's edge. A visit to the Pitons is one of things you must do in your lifetime. Snaking up the misty, jungle-covered, boulder-strewn mountainside for the huge views from the top, is an experience well worth the hike. Accomplishing one of the top 5 things to do on the World Heritage Site.

Soufriere Rum & Chocolate Tour & Tasting

Time: 8:30am – 4:30pm Daily

Sail down the west coast to Soufriere where you will first see the famous Pitons as they rise majestically out of the sea, followed by a drive through the town of Soufriere on your way up to the Morne Coubaril Estate. Relive the tradition and culture at the Morne Coubaril Estate, an original 18th-century working plantation. Where you will get a Tour & Tasting of the Rums & Chocolates all made locally.

Come time travel to an 18th century sugar cane plantation where the journey of cane juice is turned into the finest rum. St. Lucia is also famous for its Chocolate, so you will get the chance to walk through and learn the process of turning the cocoa bean into Chocolate! On your journey through the plantation, you will notice the vegetation and the replica of 18th century houses, where you will end your guided tour and sample some of the local Rums & Chocolates. Following this a fresh local buffet lunch will be served on the Estate.

Fond Petit Maroon Waterfall Tour

Time: Daily upon availability (Min 4 pax)

Cost: \$130US per person

The Fond Petit Waterfall is one of the best kept secrets in the Deniere Riviere, Mabouya Valley area. This splendidly cool waterfall with its towering presence of over 70ft high represents a form of spiritual rebirth and awakening, in its refreshingly cool outpouring of ritual cleansing. Its quiet roar is set in an atmosphere surrounded by luxuriant tropical forest naturally airbrushed by the masterful strokes of the creator, creating a steady pattern of endless rhythm. Accessible by brigand trails centuries old in the misty mountains of La Sorciere the waterfall mirrors a scene so perfect of an invigorating experience that should not escape you.

Birdwatching Tour

Time: Daily upon availability (Min 4 pax)

Cost: \$130US per person

This is a special tour for passionate bird lovers and nature enthusiast, of which St. Lucia has a lot to offer, where clients get a chance to see the endemic St. Lucia Parrot as well as other interesting birds. The avifauna of Saint Lucia includes a total of 191 species according to Bird Checklists of the World as of May 2021. Of them, five are endemic, three have been introduced by humans, and 116 are rare or accidental. There are also two subspecies endemic to the island. Six species are globally threatened. Tour takes place in the Government Forest Reserve.
